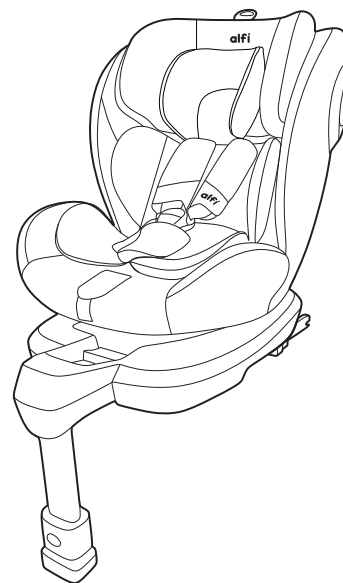

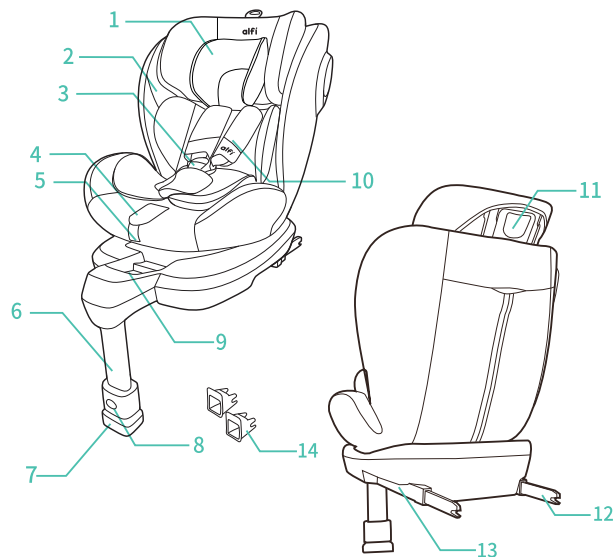
This child restraint is approved to GB 27887-2011 and UN ECE regulation 44, 04 series of amendments. Please read all the instructions in this manual before installing and using the product.

## WARNING

! DO NOT have your child in swaddled clothes when using this child restraint in rear facing or forward facing mode, because this may prevent your child from being properly and securely fastened by the shoulder harnesses and the harnesses between thighs.

! DO NOT leave this child restraint unsecured in your vehicle because an unsecured child restraint can be thrown around and may injure occupants in a sharp - turn, sudden stop, or collision. Remove it if not in regular use.

! NEVER install this child restraint on any vehicle seat equipped with safety airbags when used in rear facing mode.

! NEVER use a second-hand child restraint or a child restraint whose history you do not know because they may have structural damage that endangers your child's safety.

! DO NOT use this child restraint as a regular chair as it tends to fall down and could injure the child.

! DO NOT put anything other than the recommended soft goods in this child restraint.

! DO NOT carry this child restraint with a child in it.

## WARNING

! Do not allow the child restraint harness or buckles to become trapped or caught in the vehicle seat or door.

! To avoid suffocation, remove plastic bag and packaging materials before using this product. The plastic bag and packaging materials should then be kept away from babies and children.

! Do not place any objects in the load leg area in front of your base.

! Frequently check the FIX guides for dirt and clean them if necessary. Reliability can be effected by ingress of dirt, dust, food particles etc.

! Remove this child restraint from the vehicle seat when it is not in use for a long period of time.

! Consult the retailer for issues concerning maintenance, repair and part replacement.

! DO NOT install this child restraint under the following conditions:

1. Vehicle seats with lap belt or 3-point-belt.
2. Vehicle seats facing sideways or rearward with respect to the running direction of the vehicle.
3. Vehicle seats movable during installation.

## Product Information

Notice regarding universal category (Group 0+ I II II)



1. This is a "Universal" child restraint. It is approved to Regulation No.44,04 series of amendments. For general use in vehicles and it will fit most, but not all, car seats.
2. A correct fit is likely if the vehicle manufacture has declared in the vehicle handbook that the vehicle is capable of accepting a "Universal" child restraint for this age group.
3. This child restraint has been classified as "Universal" under more stringent conditions than those which applied to earlier designs which do not carry this notice.
4. If in doubt, consult either the child restraint manufacture or the retailer.

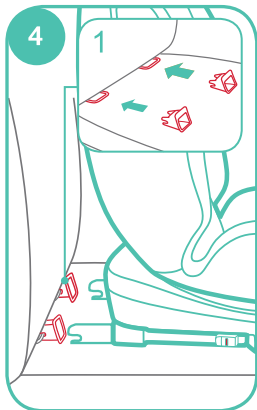
## Installing the Base

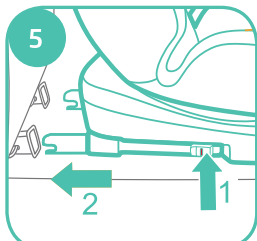
1. After placing the base on the vehicle seat, pull the load leg downward to floor.(Fig.3)



2. Insert FIX guides to assist with installation.(Fig.4.1)



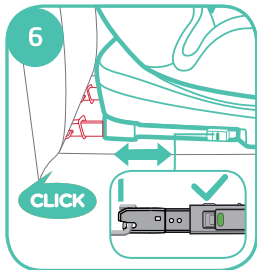
3. Press the FIX adjuster button to extend the FIX. (Fig.5)



4. Make sure that both FIX connectors are securely attached to their FIX anchor points. (Fig.6)

! Make sure that both ISOFIX connectors are securely attached to their FIX anchor points. The colors of the indicators on the both FIX connectors should be completely green.(Fig.6.1)

! Check to make sure the base is securely installed by pulling on the both FIX connectors.



5. After attaching the ISOFIX, pull the load leg downward to floor. When the load leg(Fig.7) indicator shows green, the load leg is installed correctly.(Fig.8)

! The load leg has 14 positions. When the load leg indicator shows red this means the load leg is in the wrong position.

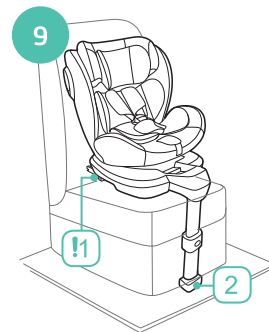
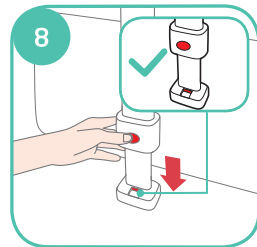
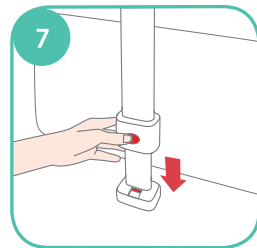
! Make sure the load leg is in full contact with the vehicle floor pan. Red means it is installed incorrectly.

! Squeeze the load leg releasing button, then adjust the load leg length.

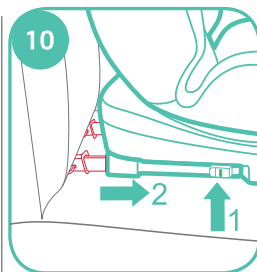
6. The completely assembled base is shown as the FIX connectors must be attached and locked onto the FIX anchor points. (Fig.9.1)

! The load leg must be installed correctly with green indicator. (Fig.9.2)

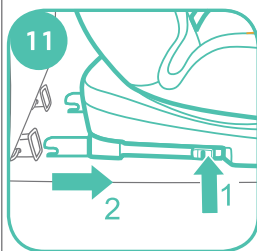
7. Please refer to rear facing mode and recline positions mode insetion to use the child restraint.



8. To remove from the vehicle press the FIX adjuster button (Fig.10.1) and pull the base back from the seat. (Fig.10.2)



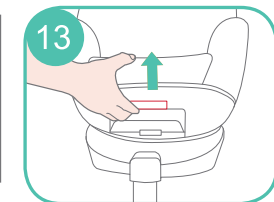
9. Press the second lock and release button on both FIX connectors and pull the base outward. (Fig.11)



## Recline Adjustment

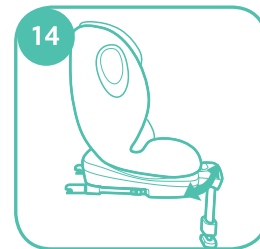

Squeeze the recline adjustment-button (Fig.13), to adjust the child restraint to the proper position. The recline angles are shown as (Fig.14).



! Please recheck the load leg position after reclining.

There are recline positions for rearfacing mode and 4 recline positions for forward facing mode. (Fig.14)



## Height Adjustment for Head Support and Shoulder Harnesses

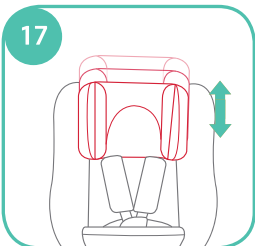
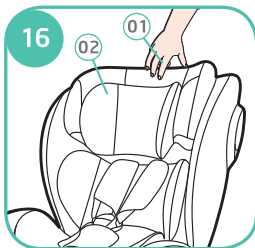

1. Please adjust the head support and check if the shoulder harnesses are at the correct height according to (Fig.15)

! When used rear facing and forward facing, the shoulder harness height must be even with or just above the child shoulders. (Fig.15)



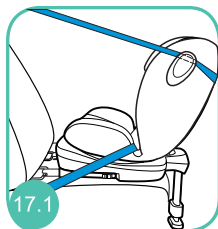
2. Pull the headrest up by the adjust handle (Fig.16.1) meanwhile pull up or push down on the head support until it snaps into one of the 10 positions. The head support positions are shown as (Fig.17).



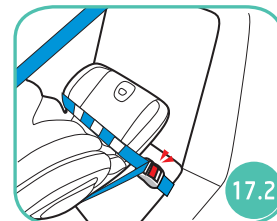

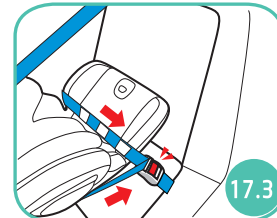

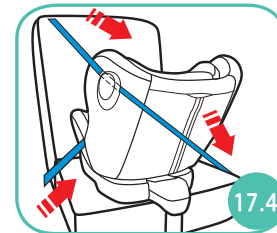
Through the bottom of the seat, and fasten the 3 - point safety belt to the maximum



Pass the seat belt attachment through the seat belt guide slots on both sides of the seat and fasten the buckle

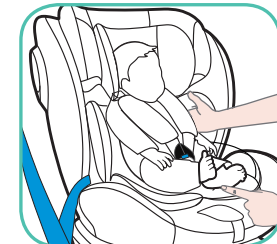


Pass the shoulder strap of the 3-point safety belt through the seat belt guide hook on the side of the seat

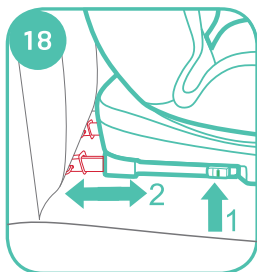
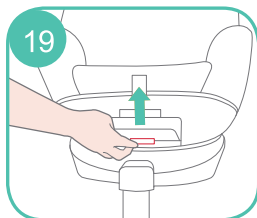
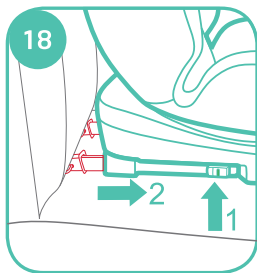
! Please install the child restraint on the rear vehicle seat and then put the child in the child restraint.

1. Press the FIX adjuster button (Fig.18.1) and pull the base back from the vehicle seat. (Fig.18.2)

2. Press the rotating button to rotate for easier side loading/un-loading of the child, then rotate back to desired direction. (Fig.19)(Fig.21)

3. If a tighter install or increased cabin space is required, then press the FIX adjuster button (Fig.20.1) and push to adjust (Fig.20.2)

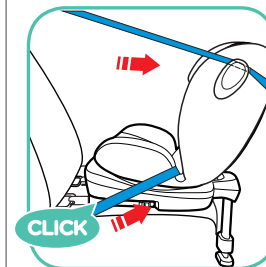
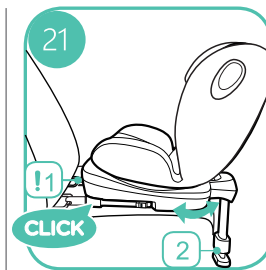


4. Install the child restraint in the rear facing mode as (Fig.21)

! The FIX connectors must be attached and locked onto the FIX anchor points. (Fig.21.1)

! The load leg must be installed correctly with green indicator. (Fig.21.2)

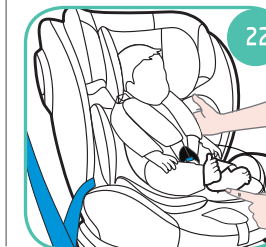
5. Binding the baby car seat with 3-Point safety belt in the way like Mode 1, see (Fig.17.1-Fig.17.4)



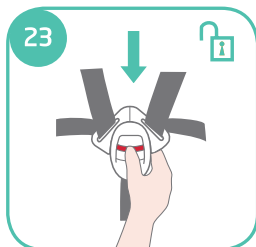

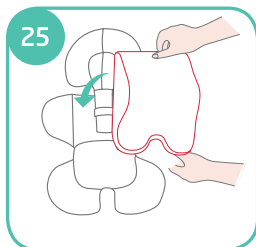
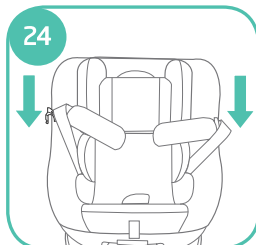
1. Press the webbing adjustment button, while pulling out the shoulder harnesses to the proper length. (Fig.22)








2. Unlock the buckle of the harnesses by pressing the red button. (Fig. 23)



3. Open the safety buckle and place the seat belt on both sides of the seat into the child. (Fig. 24)

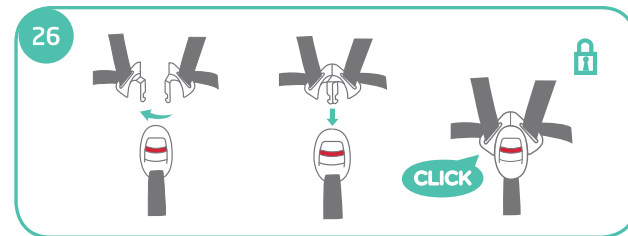


 <p>We recommend using the full cushion while the baby is 0-6 months or until they out grow the insert. The cushion increases side impact protection.</p>	 <p>Detach the snaps on the head support to remove the head portion of the cushion.</p>	 <p>Remove the head support portion of the cushion when the child head no longer sits comfortably.</p>

5. Place the child into the child restraint and pass both arms through the harnesses.

! After the child is seated, recheck whether the shoulder harnesses are at the proper height.

6. Engage the buckle. Please refer to (Fig. 26)



7. Pull down the adjustment webbing and adjust it to the proper length to make sure your child is properly secured. (Fig. 27)

! Make sure the space between the child and the Shoulder Harness Straps is about the thickness of one hand.

8. If steps (Fig. 22)(Fig. 23)(Fig. 24) are taken when arriving at your destination whilst removing the child then the harness will be positioned so that it is out of the way and ready for loading upon your return to the vehicle.



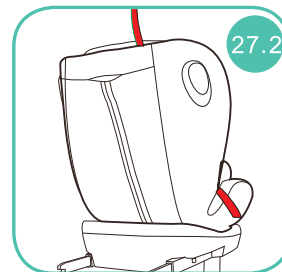

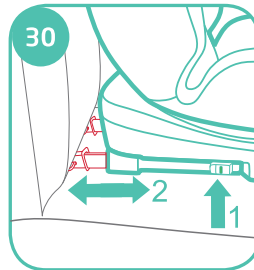
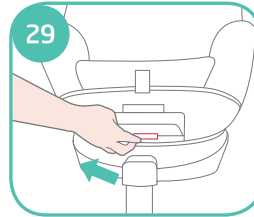
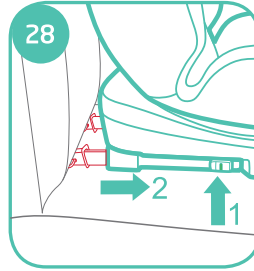
! Please install the child restraint on the rear vehicle seat and then put the child in the child restraint.

1. Press the FIX adjuster button (Fig.28.1) and pull the base back from the vehicle seat. (Fig.28.2)

2. Press the rotating button to rotate for easier side loading/unloading of the child, then rotate back to desired direction (Fig. 29)(Fig.31)

3. If a tighter install or increased cabin space is required, then press the FIX adjuster button (Fig.30.1) and push to adjust (Fig.30.2)

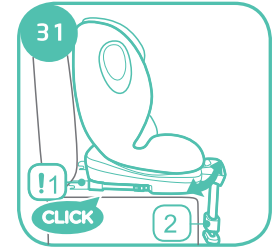


4. Install the child restraint in the forward facing mode as (Fig.31)

! The FIX connectors must be attached and locked onto the FIX anchor points. (Fig.31.1)

! The load leg must be installed correctly with green indicator.(Fig. 31.2)

5. Binding the baby car seat with 3-Point safety belt in the way like Mode 1, see (Fig.27.1-Fig.27.4)

## Securing Child

After the child is placed into the seat, check whether the Shoulder Harness Straps are at proper height.

1. Press the webbing adjustment button, while pulling out the shoulder harnesses to the proper length. (Fig.32)

2. Unlock the buckle of the harnesses by pressing the red button. (Fig. 33)

3. Fix the buckles on the both sides of seat to make placing the child in forward facing mode more convenient.(Fig. 34)

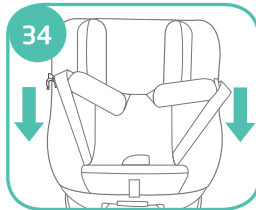
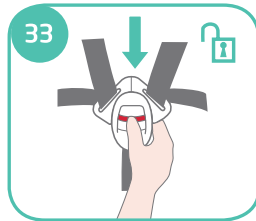
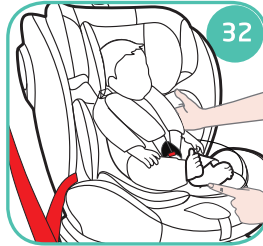
! When installing the child restraint in the forward facing mode, do not use the cushion.

4. Place the child into the child restraint and pass both arms through the harnesses.

! When used rear facing and forward facing, the shoulder harness height must be between with or just above the child shoulders. (Fig. 15)

! After the child is seated, recheck-whether the shoulder harnesses are at the proper height.

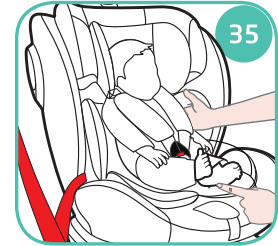
5. Engage the buckle. (Fig.26)



6. Pull down the adjustment webbing and adjust it to the proper length to make sure your child is properly secured. (Fig. 35)

! Make sure the space between the child and the Shoulder Harness Straps is about the thickness of one hand.

7. If steps (Fig. 32)(Fig. 33)(Fig. 34) are taken when arriving at your destination whilst removing the child, then the harness will be positioned so that it is out of the way and ready for loading upon your return to the vehicle.

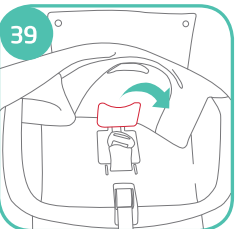
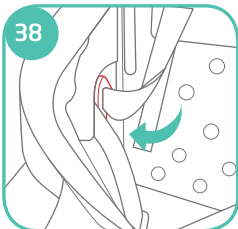
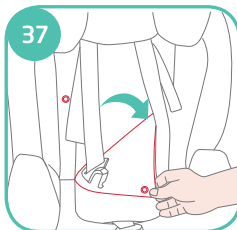
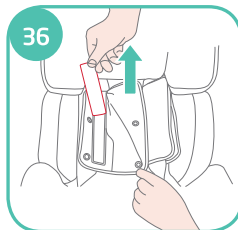
**3-point safety belts+FIX**

! Please install the child safety seat into the car seat before allowing children to ride.

! When clamping the child safety seat, adjust the base to the fourth stage.

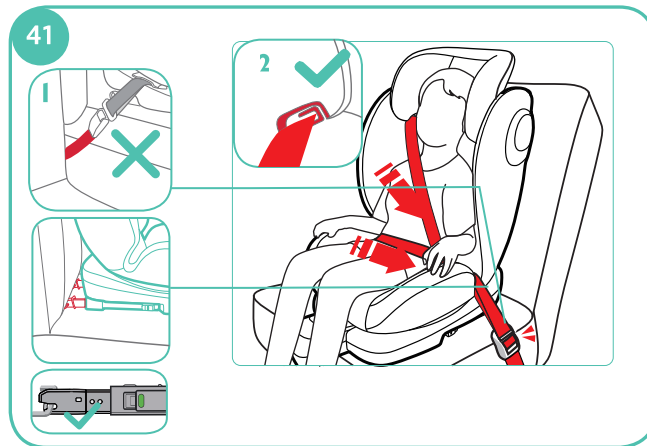
! FOR Child between needs to be fixed with the car seat belt. The small seat cushion should be removed. Crotch sheath and shoulder strap sheath, and keep the shoulder strap and safety buckle well hidden.

! Adjust the straps to an appropriate length before storing the straps and safety.

! Pass the shoulder strap through the shoulder guide, the belt through the seat slot, and then insert the seat belt buckle into the buckle and tighten the seat belt. 41

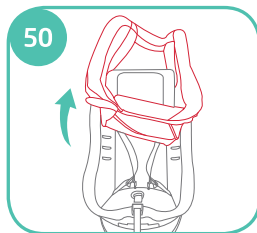


## Detach Clothes Cover

## Maintenance

- ! Please wash the seat cover and inner padding with cold water under.
- ! Do not iron.
- ! Do not bleach or dry clean the soft goods.
- ! Do not use undiluted detergents gasoline or other organic solvent to wash the child restraint or base. It may cause damage to the child restraint.
- ! Do not wring out the seat cover and inner padding to dry. It may leave the seat cover and inner padding with wrinkles.
- ! Please hang dry the seat cover and inner padding in the shade.
- ! Please remove the child restraint and base from the vehicle seat if not in use for a long period of time. Put the child restraint in a cool, dry place where your child cannot access it.
